

Traffic Info

- All roads on course remain open to local vehicle traffic but shared with runners/ walkers
- Police will be at all major intersections and volunteer marshals at those intersections which are less busy
- Traffic is controlled by police on the course when runners are on it
- Runners have the right of way at all times
- Directions from RCMP, traffic marshals must be obeyed at all times
- Traffic fines are double for violations on the race course

ALTERNATE ROUTES

- Clifton Road traffic use Sonora/Broadview/ Glenburne/Glenmeadows
- Traffic can cross the course in breaks of runners/walkers
- SB & NB Glenmore can pass through High Rd./Summit Dr.,

DELAYS ARE TO BE EXPECTED

COMPLETE CLOSURES FROM 6:30 A.M. TO 9 A.M.

- Abbott Street from Leon to Bernard Avenues.
- Bernard Avenue from Mill to Richter Streets.
- Richter Street from Bernard to Clement Avenue.

COMPLETE AND PARTIAL ROAD CLOSURES FROM 7 A.M. TO 2 P.M.

- Water Street from Cawston Avenue to Ellis Street open to northbound traffic only.
- Clement Avenue from Sunset to Richter open to eastbound traffic only.
- Clement Avenue from Richter Street to Gordon Drive will be closed to westbound traffic.
- Clement Avenue from Gordon Drive to High Road will have two-way traffic on the south side use caution.
- High Road from Clifton Road to Glenmore Road, eastbound traffic only.
- Clifton Road from Clement Avenue to High Road, open to traffic expect delays.
- Summit Drive from High to Valley Road is open to eastbound traffic only.
- Valley Road from Summit Drive to Yates Road is open to northbound traffic only.
- Valley Road from Yates to Cross Roads is open to southbound traffic only.
- Valley Road from Union Road to Cross road closed completely.
- Valley Road from Union to Curtis Road is open to southbound traffic only.
- Curtis Road from Valley to Sexsmith Roads is open to northbound traffic only.
- Mail Road from Longhill to Sexsmith Roads is open to northbound traffic only.
- Longhill Road between Valley and Mail Roads is open to eastbound traffic only.
- Sunset Drive closed at Clement Avenue.
- Richter Street north of Clement is open to northbound traffic only.



B.C. Athletics road running rules apply. It is the responsibility of athletes to be familiar with these rules. For Sunday events, no running strollers, roller blades, support vehicles, escort runners or cyclists allowed. For Saturday 5K Fun Walk/Run, strollers are welcome. Headphones or any other personal listening devices are discouraged.

The entire BMO OM race course will be marked with orange traffic cones. Athletes MUST stay within the traffic cones unless otherwise directed by an BMO OM official or course marshal. Be aware that the board walk and brick work section of race course is uneven. See race course map.

BMO OM Medical personnel and officials reserve the right to remove any athlete from the race judged to be physically incapable of continuing without health risk.
